1. Briefly describe the artifact and the context in which it was created. What was your individual contribution(s)?

This artifact is used to **model and facilitate the safe**, **healthy**, **legal**, **and ethical use of digital information**. I developed a copyright power point presentation addressing the **safe**, **healthy**, **legal**, **and ethical use of digital information**.
