Candidates conduct needs assessments to determine school-wide, faculty, grade-level, and subject area strengths and weaknesses to inform the content and delivery of technology-based professional learning programs.

1. Briefly describe the artifact and the context in which it was created. What was your individual contribution(s)?

This artifact is the development an **assessment** of a **faculty** members technology needs, **strengths**, and **weaknesses**. There is a write-up and two surveys that are included in this artifact. LoTi design is used in the development of the surveys.

2. Explain how this artifact demonstrates mastery of the standard/element under which it is placed.

This artifact demonstrates mastery in **needs assessment** of a **faculty** member and subject area **strengths and weaknesses** because an assessment was developed and administered. I developed and administered two LoTi survey's in order to assess a collaborative teacher's **strengths and weaknesses** in technology. One survey that I developed was a technology survey, which asked questions about technology skills and technology application in the classroom. The other survey I developed and implemented is a teacher adopter survey. This survey asked questions about integrating technology. I used these **assessments** to determine **strengths and weaknesses** in technology and technology standards. I follow-up on theses assessments with a series of coaching sessions.
